Eiswein (Ice Wine) is a vibrant, racy dessert wine produced from grapes that have frozen solid on the vine. The grapes are picked in the wee hours of the morning and pressed while still frozen, resulting in an extremely concentrated wine with juicy sweetness and a firm, crisp finish.
