SPÄTLESE

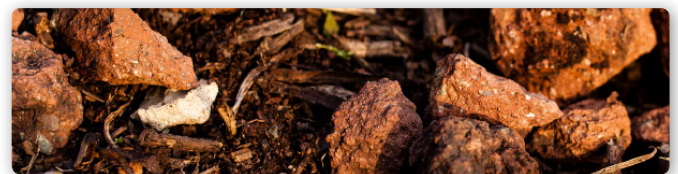
Spätlese is German for "late picked." It has more richness and body than Kabinett because the grapes are allowed to ripen for an extra week or more. The extra hang time on the vine allows for greater development of flavor and aroma.



ÜRZIGER WÜRZGARTEN

[erts-iger verts-garten] (The Spice Garden of Ürzig)

Blazing red and insanely steep, this vineyard fills a picturesque amphitheater formed by a dramatic bend in the Mosel river. Although it is directly adjacent to the vineyards of Erden, this site produces a completely different kind of wine, with unique exotic, spicy aromas and a mesmerizing earthiness.



WEATHERED RED VOLCANIC SOIL

The weathered red volcanic and slate soil of Ürziger Würzgarten makes it unique on the Mosel. High iron content in the soil gives the vineyard its vivid color.



THE DR. LOOSEN ESTATE, BERNKASTEL / MOSEL

This offers a ripe nose of fresh herbs, spices, melon and pear. The wine is nicely ripe and juicy on the palate and leaves a gorgeous and delicately ripe feel on the palate and in the long and gorgeously zesty finish. 2025-2040
