**The Wine**

Villa Wolf Pinot Noir Rosé has an excellent balance which is already showcased in the beautiful salmon color of the wine, not too dark not too light. On the palate it gives you the guilty pleasure of delightful fruitiness, but then, with the help of the crisp acidity, it has a clean and crisp finish so as to almost finish on the drier, more sophisticated side. It is perfect for hanging out on the patio with friends and a wide variety of grilled fare.

The goal at Villa Wolf is to produce wines that express the pure, authentic terroir of the Pfalz. Made in the classic style of the Pfalz, Villa Wolf wines are dry and full-bodied, with fully ripe fruit flavors and a characteristic stoniness in the aroma. To preserve the naturally high quality of the vineyards, we employ sustainable viticultural practices and emphasize gentle handling of the fruit through traditional, minimalist winemaking.

**From the press / awards:**

*[Gold medal] The Fifty Best , 2017 vintage*

*Made from grapes grown in Germany's Pfalz region in vineyards noted for weathered sandstone soil, this wine was fermented and aged in stainless steel tanks and lightly filtered before bottling.*

*Aroma: Strawberry, raspberry, cranberry, cherry, black currant, pomegranate, nectarine, melon, candied cranberries, floral, steely, crisp, clean.*

*Palate: Crisp green apple, red apple, strawberry, blueberry, plum, cherry, pomegranate, watermelon, fresh citrus, lemon, candied strawberries, sour apple candy, effervescent, touch of sweetness-touch of spritz.*

*Finish: Green apple, sour apple, raspberry, berry, cranberry, pomegranate, lemon, lime, citrus, minerality, crisp, appealingly put together, aperitif wine.*
