



Dr. Loosen Knochentrocken Riesling is made in a crisp, very dry style. The idea for this wine was driven by two of our interns who had this as their project, and they were also aided by an intern out the printing company who designed the label. The result is an extremely dry style of wine that is definitely a departure from the typical style of dry Rieslings from Dr. Loosen, but it is an excellent wine with food, especially if the food itself has acidity.

When Ernst Loosen assumed ownership in 1988, he realized that, with old ungrafted vines in some of Germany's best-rated vineyards, he had the raw materials to create stunningly intense, world-class wines.
